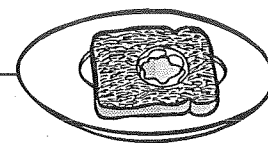


# One-Eyed Toast

MATERIALS NEEDED/DIRECTIONS



Serves: One

Food Items	Cooking Items
bread eggs butter (stick)	cutting board 2" round cookie cutter small mixing bowl frying pan stove dinner knife spatula oven mitt hot pad dinner plate

## Directions

1. Place 1 piece of bread on the cutting board.
2. Use the round cookie cutter to make a hole in the center of the bread.
3. Crack 1 egg on the side of the bowl, and pour it into the bowl.
4. Place the frying pan on a stove-top burner.
5. Use the dinner knife to cut 2 tablespoons of butter, and place the butter in the pan.
6. Turn the heat on the burner to medium, and melt the butter.
7. Place the bread in the pan, and pour the egg into the hole in the bread.
8. Cook the egg until the clear part turns white and the bread is brown.
9. Use the spatula to turn the bread over, and cook the other side until it is brown.
10. Turn off the burner.
11. Use the oven mitt to move the pan off the burner and onto the hot pad.
12. Use the spatula to place the one-eyed toast on the plate.
